What's New at PAH: Rehoming, Rescue & Community

For over 10 years, Pittwater Animal Hospital has proudly served as the local council pound, helping to rehome countless stray kittens — from snuggly lap cats to the occasional feisty adventurer. This year, the council has chosen to move in a different direction, and we will no longer act as the official pound. As a result, we'll no longer be rehoming stray kittens.

However, while we're no longer the council's rehoming facility, we remain deeply committed to animal welfare. We continue to support wonderful local rescue groups by providing desexing, vaccinations, and veterinary care for animals in foster care with **Dachshund Rescue, Urban Cat Alliance, Kitty Kat Rescue, Safe Rehoming, Rose Hill Community Cats**, and **The Rabbit Sanctuary**. We also care for injured native wildlife in collaboration with **Sydney Wildlife** and **WIRES**.

Throughout the year, we proudly run charity events to give back — from last year's 50km walk to raise funds for the **Wildlife Van**, to this year's **Big Morning Tea supporting the Cancer Council**. Thank you for always being part of our caring community.

V June is Seniors Month – Book Now for Peace of Mind

This month, we're offering extended health checks for senior pets (and younger pets with ongoing health concerns).

Cats: \$385 (normally \$485) Dogs: \$430 (normally \$580)

Your pet will receive:

- A full-body systems examination
- Lumps, rashes and ears checked
- Comprehensive blood tests including heartworm screening for dogs
- Blood pressure testing (cats) or FIV/FeLV (leukaemia and AIDS) testing
- Urine testing please bring a sample if you can!
- Cytology (ears, skin or lumps, if needed)
- A detailed written report and future care plan
- Enrolment in our Pittwater Dental Program (if needed)
